How to Apply

There are 2 ways you can apply!

★ You can apply for one of our summer jobs by registering at www.istplus.com/watjobs

Once registered we will work to match you up with employers. If selected you will be invited to interview either at our jobs fair in February or via virtual hire (skype)

Once you've been hired you'll need to complete the steps below to apply for the J1 visa.

★ If you already have a summer job lined up you can complete the application form (this will include the JOB OFFER from your US Company) see www.istplus.com/watusa

Send your completed application to us.

Our teams in the US will then contact your employer and verify some details.

Once this is done it should take approximately 2-3 weeks to get the legal paperwork (the DS-2019 Certificate) from the USA.

You'll then be able to book and attend a face to face interview at the US Embassy (www.istplus.com/usembassy)

This is THE Summer J1 Visa Programme for UK university students!

Each year, thousands of international students go to the US to work over the summer - in Theme Parks, Beach clubs, restaurants - pretty much any seasonal job!

The Summer Work and Travel J1 Visa Programme is specifically designed to allow full time university level students (including final year) to go to the US and work between June 1st and September 15th - with up to 30 days travel at the end.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be currently enrolled as a full time university student
- That's it!



While many students get their jobs independently we've also got US employers looking for students for next summer!

What's included in the Fees?

What participants get on Summer Work and Travel USA

Legal Sponsorship: The Legal Sponsorship and documentation required to apply for the J1 visa (this is known as the DS-2019 Certificate of Eligibility)

Insurance: Comprehensive medical and liability insurance for the duration of their time in the USA - for full details on this please see ciee.org/insurance

24/7 emergency support: Our teams are available 24 hours a day if you have an emergency. Call them toll free from any phone in the USA

Participant information and Extras: Every participant gets a comprehensive handbook - as well as access to discounts and extras.

Online Orientation: Every participant must complete an online orientation prior to their departure for the USA - this is full of useful and important information about the J1 programme, living in the USA and staying safe.

SEVIS Fees: SEVIS stands for Student and Exchange Visitor Information System. Its a fee the US Government takes for every J1 Visa application - **it's also included in the fees!**



Getting a Job

The vast majority of UK based students get their summer jobs in the US independently - native English speakers find it much easier to get employment in a customer facing roll in hotels, restaurants etc.
